The Philippine Consulate General in San Francisco is pleased to announce that it will provide consular services at the locations and on dates indicated below. Services to be offered are Philippine passport application, legalization of documents (affidavits, powers of attorney, deeds, other legal instruments), Civil Registry (reports of births, marriages and deaths) and Dual Citizenship application. Before you go

Set an appointment.

Consular outreach missions are on a per-appointment basis. Please check the consular outreach schedule below for the contact details to set your next appointment.

Bring all required documents.

Each service has its own set of personal document requirements. Please read and review our website, www.philippinesanfrancisco.org, carefully and take note of the requirements so that you can come to the outreach prepared. This could mean bringing original, certified true copies, and/or photocopies of each document. Save time and money by making photocopies before coming to the outreach venue.

Fill out forms and complete the requirements before you arrive.

Come prepared. Download the necessary forms at our website prior to your visit. Make sure that all applications are filled out, photocopied, and completed with the required signatures. Bring three 2x2 pictures with white background if you are applying for dual citizenship. This will save you time and money, as photocopying and picture-taking services are cheaper in outside shops plus will save you the hassle of falling in yet another line. Bring the right amount of money.

The Consulate only accepts postal money order, cashier's check and cash. Personal checks, personal money orders, and credit cards will not be accepted. Applications will not be processed until the required fee is paid. Please check our website, www.philippinesanfrancisco.org, for the schedule of fees.

No entrance fees.

The Consulate and the Filipino Community outreach organizers have reached an understanding that there will be no entrance fees charged. Any donations to the FilCom organizations hosting the outreach are strictly voluntary.

Thank the local Filipino Community organizers as well.

The Consulate is able to conduct consular outreach programs through the invitation and hosting of Filipino Community organizers. Many of the people you will see working during an outreach are normal people such as yourselves volunteering their time to help the Consulate provide public service. This is so that you won't have to travel all the way to San Francisco.
